This nutrition profiling system measures the nutritional quality of our products. Foods must meet the criteria for either providing a positive contribution to the diet or being lower in calories, saturated fat, sodium, and added sugars. Criteria provided below is per labeled serving size<sup>1</sup>.

### Category Definitions for Nutrition Focused Foods:

Our categories are informed by regulatory definitions and typical consumer use of our products. Products are assessed based on the category in which they fit.

<b>Snacks, Sides &amp; Beverages</b>	Foods that are typically eaten as a snack, side dish, or beverage. <b>Entrees, Soups, &amp; Sauces</b>	Foods that are typically eaten as the main portion of a meal or used to flavor and prepare the main portion of a meal. Other foods may be added, but this is the primary choice for a meal occasion.	<i>Campbell's®</i> soups, <i>SpaghettiO's®</i> , <i>Prego®</i> Italian sauces, <i>Campbell's®</i> cooking sauces, <i>Rao's®</i> Italian sauce, <i>Swanson®</i> broth.
